








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LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT






The Social Media Audience Analysis Report provides a comprehensive overview of the demographics, interests, and behaviors of the audience.


Visitor Demographics

Eclipse Event Planning

Leveraged local partnerships with schools, businesses, non-profits, and the City of Washington to plan a three day festival where we welcomed visitors from more than 12 states.

Sustaining Hoosier Communities

Partnered with IU Center for Rural Engagement to gain capacity for 5 microprojects connected to downtown.

Lunch & Learns

Programmed in partnership with the ISBDC and Ivy Tech to support businesses and furthering education within 6 areas of focus and taught by experience instructors.

DORA Planning

Assisted the City of Washington with researching DORA communities, mapping the DORA district, designing signage, and informing downtown businesses on how to prepare.

Downtown Revitalization Plan




